9.4 - Trafton Discussion

- I. Mrs. Labreck stated that the camp grounds will open the end of the May.
- II. Mr. Pelletier stated that we needed to find someone to oversee the campground. That was agreed by most of the board
- III. Mr. Brooker stated that he knew of someone that was interested last year in overseeing the campground.
- IV. Mr. Elliott stated that a contractor needs to be found and the work needs to be started on the bathhouse as soon as possible, along with any other repairs that need to be made.
- V. All agreed that this needed to start taking place sooner than later because they only have two months till it opens.
- VI. It was also stated that if the campground was made to be ATV friendly it would help with brining in new people to stay.
- VII. The picnic tables will now be stored on base and the Job Corps will continue to work on all the picnic tables till all are repaired.

9.5 - Highway Dept - plow quote

- Mr. Keiser of the highway department explained the plow that they
 have is in such disrepair that it would cost more to fix it than to replace it.
- II. Mr. Keiser has three quotes but believes spending more on a quality plow that it will last longer is the best option for the town.
