
“Do you favor filing a petition for withdrawal with the board of directors of Regional School Unit 39 and with the Commissioner of Education, authorizing the withdrawal committee to expend \$40,000 and authorizing the selectpersons to request funds from the Limestone School Reserve and to issue notes if needed in the name of the Town of Limestone or otherwise pledge the credit of the Town of Limestone in an amount not to exceed \$40,000 for this purpose?”
