

Town of Limestone

Roadways and Sidewalks Ordinance

Section 1: Definitions

"Public Way" shall mean a way, owned and maintained by the State, a county or a municipality, over which the general public has a right to pass on foot or by motor vehicle.

"Business District" shall mean the following:

From the intersection of Route 1A (Main Street) onto Route 89 (Access Highway) ending at the intersection of Route 89 (Access Highway) with High Street;

From the intersection of Route 1A (Main Street) and Route 89 (Access Highway) to the intersection of Route 1A (Main Street) with Burleigh Street; and

From the intersection of Route 1A (Main Street) and Route 229 (Grand Falls Road) with Brook Street.

"Windrow" shall mean a long lined pile of snow placed by machine.

Section 2: Snow Removal

1. Except as provided in Section 5 herein, snow or ice may not be deposited on the public way.
2. Snow or ice may not be deposited on the private property of another without written permission of the owner of such property.
3. Snow or ice may not be deposited to a height as to obstruct vision at intersections or driveways when connected to the public way.
4. Snow or ice may not be deposited on fire hydrants or in such a manner to impede access to fire hydrants.

Section 3: Mowing

1. Grass clippings or debris may not be placed in the public way.

Section 4: Parking

1. No person shall park on the street from November 1st to April 15th between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., so not to hinder with snow removal by the Town of Limestone Public Works Department.
2. No person shall park on a sidewalk or pedestrian walking area.
3. No person shall park any vehicle upon a street or highway in a manner or under conditions as to interfere with the free movement of vehicular traffic or proper street or highway maintenance

Section 5: Exceptions

1. The Town of Limestone Public Works is exempt from all sections of this ordinance.
2. Prior to the removal of snow and ice by the Town of Limestone Public Works Department located in the "Business District" a business owner or their designee may place snow or ice into the "windrow" that the Public Works has yet to remove. (Once the "windrow" has been removed the business owner or their designee will **NOT** be allowed to place snow or ice in the public way)

Section 6: Violations

1. Any violation of Section 4 subsections 1 and 2 of this ordinance may be subject to a citation not to exceed \$ 25.00 and the vehicle in question may be towed at the violators expense and subsequent costs of storage of said vehicle shall be the responsibility of the violator.
2. The first violation of Section 2 subsections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Section 3 sub section 1 shall receive a warning and violator must correct the issue within 24 hours of warning.
3. Any subsequent violations of Section 2 sub sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Section 3 sub section 1, shall receive a citation which shall be issued with a fine amount not to exceed \$25.00 and the violator must correct issue within 24 hours of citation.
4. If issues addressed and related to Section 2 and Section 3 are not corrected within the 24-hour period the Town of Limestone Public Works Department may correct the issue and any cost related shall be the responsibility of the violator, not to exceed \$100.00.
