- c. Georgette Muldrow helped to decorate the Library in preparation for July 4th festivities. Karallena Castaway did face-painting at our Children's Ice Cream Social.

8. Projects:

- a. Lisa continues to visit the Cuthbertson Family Child Care once a week.
- b. We care used by adults working with school aged children. Currently, there are at least 4 pairs who work in our library. Most of these visits have now ended and will resume once school starts again in August.
- c. Job Corp student visits will resume in the Fall.
- d. Our Spring Adult Craft Night, sponsored by the Friends of the Library was on June 1 and attended by 25 people. They made wood flower garden stakes which they painted and wrote a sentiment in the middle. (We are still finding paint to be washed off the walls and floor!) These nights are always in high demand and the instructor, Jane Griffeth, has agreed to add a second night to our next event.
- e. We had a very successful pre-summer reading event with Magician Greg McAdams and his dog Axel. We had 39 children and 19 adults in attendance for a total of 58 people. This event was covered by WAGM and was seen on the evening news.
- f. Children's Ice Cream Social. Our Ice Cream Social was lots of fun! We read a story called, The Night Before the Fourth of July by Natasha WIng. The children then went downstairs and painted

fireworks, some made a sports related magnet and all had ice cream with toppings. We had 28 children in attendance.

g. We had a research inquiry regarding a picture posted on Maine Memory Network regarding a photo of a World War II Memorial in Limestone. We were unable to answer the question but are still making inquiries.

h. Cary Medical Center's Health You program held a Coloring for Stress program on Thursday, June 30 from 1-3 pm. The event was attended by one person. We have informed the organizer that we would like to start an adult coloring night in the Fall. We are hoping she will return and run her program then since evenings are better for the adults in our community to attend such events.

i. Free Summer Lunch Program: We are the designated site for the Free Summer Lunch Program sponsored by the Maine Department of Education and the USDA. Beginning on June 17 and continuing through July 15, any child 18 and under is able to get a free lunch at the Library between 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM.
