Limestone’s 2018 4th of July Parade is scheduled for Wednesday, July 4th at 2 pm. Line-up for the parade begins at 12 pm at the Limestone Community School.

Please do not wait until last minute to line up !!

Each entry will be judged based on the category you select to be judged within. This is indicated on the attached parade application. **Judging will take place prior to the start of the Parade, so please be at the school by 1:00 p.m so the judges have enough time to see your entry! Trophies will be awarded in each category to the parade entry that best represented the theme of the parade as well as its category.**

Parade Route is as follows: starts at the Limestone Community School – goes down FFA Avenue – left onto Main Street, going down through Town – turning left onto Foster Ave – and turning left onto High Street, heading back to the school. The parade usually lasts about an hour. Last year, we had over 100 entries and we’re hoping for the same amount this year.

The theme for this year’s parade is “Limestone Pride - Flying High”.

Throwing candy and/or fireworks is prohibited! If you want to give out candy or other items, please have someone walking by your float and handing it out.
