RE: September 2018

ACTIVITIES:

There were four automobile accidents for the month of September. We had thirty vehicle violation traffic stops for the month. 165 complaints are closed for the month, leaving ten open cases for further investigation.

On September 2nd Officer Damon Howarth was called to a possible trespass at a Grand Falls Residence. Upon arrival and through his investigation a 42 year old male was arrested and charged with Aggravated Reckless Conduct with a Firearm and Discharging a Firearm near a Residence.

On September 7th Chief Stacey Mahan received a complaint of a confrontation between two drivers on the Cote Road. Through his investigation a 32 year old male subject was arrested and charged with Criminal Threatening and Driving to Endanger for actions taken against a 25 year old female victim.

On September 12th Officer Ken Oliver was called to a family fight complaint at a Bog Road residence. Through his investigation a 43 year old female subject was charged for assaulting a 21 year old male victim.

On September 24th Officer Damon Howarth while on routine patrol stopped a vehicle and found that the 24 year old male driver had a suspended license and was in possession of drugs. Individual was arrested and transported to the Caribou Police Department for processing.
